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Enterprise Electric Safety Site Policy

All contractors on this project shall comply with the following site policy. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in removal from the job site.

- Hard Hats **ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES.**
(enclosed ceilings do not change this requirement, unless directed – otherwise by site foreman)
- No Tank Tops, Muscle Shirts, etc. Shirts must have a minimum of 4” sleeves.
- Long Pants only. No shorts or cut-offs or similar type apparel.
- Heavy-duty leather work boots or shoes must be worn.
- Eye Protection **IS REQUIRED** for any job that has a potential for eye injury such as, but not limited to: grinding, cutting clock, brick, concrete, drilling into metal etc.
- Head phones or any other audio devices that may impair your hearing are prohibited on the jobsite. A jobsite radio is allowed in certain circumstances if the volume is kept at a safe volume.

- All work at elevations of 6 feet or greater shall require fall protection. **EXCEPTIONS:** working from ladders, Work from scaffolds is 10 feet and steel erection is 25 feet and 30 feet.
- No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances shall be consumed or in possession, to include inside vehicles.
- All OSHA regulations applicable to your work or trade shall be followed.

1st offense – Banned from site for that working day.

2nd offense – Banned from site – NOT TO RETURN.

Safety Requirements of Contractors while on the Job Site

Receiving Areas

- Contractors are responsible for removing their construction trash to proper containers.
- All receiving areas must be kept free of parts and materials to allow for deliveries.
- A designated room on site will serve as the contractor's office with a desk, phone and table (if applicable)

Contractors Parking

- Contractors working inside the building must park only in designated areas. Vehicles may be towed if not parked in designated areas.
- Contractors are responsible for keeping the entire loading dock parking area clean and **free of debris and trash.**
- Welding and pipe cutting is done outside the building in a designated area.

Security and Access Control

- During construction all contractors shall enter the building through the designated areas.
- Only the freight elevator can be used for construction materials. Passenger elevators can only be used with the approval of the site supervisor. (if applicable)
- A security officer shall retain a picture ID of every contractor entering the building and give each individual

a visitor badge, which shall be displayed at all times while on the site. The visitor ID badge must be turned in when leaving the site. (if applicable)

- Lost or stolen badges must be reported to security immediately. (Government Facilities)
- All persons, packages, and/or vehicles are subject to inspection at the discretion of security. (if applicable)
- Contractors are restricted to assigned areas of work. If found in unassigned area, access to the site may be revoked.
- **Profane language and sexual harassment will not be permitted and will not be tolerated on site.**
- No contractors will use any Enterprise Electric equipment unless authorized by the foreman.

Temporary Utilities

- All extension cords must be GFI protected.
